Although the results of the French Baccalauréat have not yet been released, we are both proud and delighted to announce a **100% pass rate** for all of our students who pursued the **American High School Diploma**!

The 'Parcoursup' results have already been published, and while we await the results of the French Baccalauréat exams, our students can already rejoice! This year's results are once again brilliant: 1/3 of our Terminale students have been accepted into Sciences Po Paris; 20% have been accepted into McGill University and the London School of Economics (LSE); 1/3 have been accepted into the 'Grandes Ecoles' of Business and Engineering; 20% have been accepted into the preparatory class of their choice... RULES OF THE ESTABLISHMENT

- Punctuality and regular attendance are the first steps to academic success.
- I respect the work of my classmates.
- I respect the materials of the school.
- I tidy my things, my desk and my chair at the end of the class.
- No noise in the corridors.
- Rules of politeness and etiquette must be respected by all pupils in Cours Molière.
- No physical or verbal violence will be tolerated.
- Baseball hats are forbidden. Proper dress code is obligatory (see next page).
- Students must stand up when a teacher or senior figure team enters the room.
- Attending all exams is obligatory (if a pupil is absent, he or she will be obliged to provide a medical certificate or written permission from parents).
- As a prerogative, appointments with doctors and dentists must happen outside of school hours.
- Every absence must be imperatively reported to the administration by phone.
- Sport classes are obligatory for everybody (except if presenting a medical certificate or a written note from parents)

DRESS CODE

PRESCHOOL – PRIMARY – MIDDLE-SCHOOL – HIGH-SCHOOL

- **Kindergarteners + Primary School students (except CM1 and CM2):** Children will wear a **uniform-blouse** over their clothes, which will be provided by the school at the start of the school year. Parents wishing to order a 2nd blouse can do so from our partner **Bobine** (Bobine.fr). **Correct dress is required** (no earrings, no rings for the little ones, no piercings, no religious symbols, etc.). **Joggers, hoodies, trainers and caps are not permitted.**

Please label blouses/blazers with your child's first and last name at the beginning of the school year.

- **CE2:** pupils can choose between a blouse (supplied by the school) or a blazer (see CM1 and CM2 below).
- **CM1 & CM2 :** a navy blue blazer (for boys and girls) must be worn, and must be purchased by parents (in navy blue) **BEFORE SCHOOL YEAR STARTS.**
- **MIDDLE-SCHOOL:** navy blue blazer recommended (for girls and boys).
- **MIDDLE-SCHOOL & HIGH-SCHOOL:**

Sportswear is not permitted outside PE lessons.
