METHODS OF PAYMENT

The tuition fees, half boarding fees, and annual study hall fees are payable in one of 3 methods:

- **Method 1:** One-time Payment: before September 1st

With a 5% reduction on the amount of tuition fees, or euros.

- **Method 2:** Registration Check of 3,000 € + 3 Payments (check: August 15th ; November 15th ; February 15th)

IMPORTANT: Registration is definitive only after the school receives the check of 3,000€: **registrations are accepted only for one year long. Registrants must pay for the entire school year, even in case of cancellation.**
