#### **PRESENTATION**

Cours Molière welcomes students in small classes in a caring and highly international environment, where more than 35 nationalities are represented. It is not necessary to be bilingual to join the school.

The school's effective and innovative methods allow students to flourish in a supportive environment and achieve academic success, both in France and abroad.

- Children are welcomed from 2 and ½ -years-old in small classes (approximately 15 students per class).
- English language instruction accounts for more than 50% of the week (up to and including the Grande Section) and follows the *English National Curriculum*.
- Students at Cours Molière International School come from all over the world: English is used very spontaneously among the children and in their exchanges with adults, and as such is placed on an equal footing as French within the school.
- Supervision and security: Teachers and assistants supervise all recreational activities, meals in the cafeteria, and the daycare.

#### METHODS OF PAYMENT

The tuition fees, half boarding fees, and annual study hall fees are payable in one of 2 methods:

•	Method 1: One-time Payment before September 1st
	With a 5% reduction on the amount of tuition fees, oreuros.

• Method 2: Registration Check of 3,000€ + 3 Payments (check: August 15th; November 15th; February 15th)

IMPORTANT: Registration is definitive only after the school receives the first payment of 3,000€: registrations are accepted only for one year long. Registrants must pay for the entire school year, even in case of cancellation.

#### ■ A SUPPORTIVE TEACHING STAFF ■

- A reassuring environment: teachers are recruited for their kind and caring approach to education. Available throughout the year, they are happy to meet with parents on request.
- An international DNA: 30% of the staff members are English-speaking.

### PARENT-STAFF MEETINGS =

To keep the family informed, 2 individual meetings are organized during the year.

#### ■ THE PETIT MOLIÈRE METHOD ■

From the Toute Petite Section (TPS) to the Grande Section (G.S), teaching time is maximised in English to enable pupils to become **fully bilingual**.

In French, children are prepared for a smooth transition to Primary School: fine motor skills, advanced vocabulary, codes for becoming a pupil, etc.

A dedicated teaching team guides pupils, instilling in them a **love of learning** and the curiosity essential for success.

Thanks to our dynamic approach, teaching fully complies with the National Education curriculum and often goes beyond it.

- Small Size Classes: Our educational approach is distinguished by classes with reduced numbers of students. In groups of about 15 students, children develop in a secure and welcoming environment.
- Everyday Practice in English with Native English Speakers and English workbooks.
- Specialized care for non-francophone children is offered: English classes are based on proficiency levels and French classes (Français Langue Etrangère, or F.L.E.) are held with a specialist.
- Thanks to small class sizes, many different activities are possible: singing, art workshops, physical education, museum visits, etc.
- The Molière Spirit: Like in British schools, each student wears a coat-uniform provided by the school. This allows the child to integrate more easily with the class.
- Introductory Chinese classes every week in Kindergarten, from the Moyenne Section onwards (optional).



#### LA MATERNELLE – KINDERGARTEN

- Daily practice of English with native English-speaking teachers and activity books in English from the Petite Section onwards.
- Introduction to reading and writing from kindergarten onwards using the syllabic method, which guarantees excellent spelling and a successful transition to Primary School.
- Our goal: to promote children's development and inspire a positive outlook on learning.
- Thanks to small class sizes, there are many activities on offer (singing, art workshops, physical education, cultural development, etc.).

### ■ Le Primaire — Primary School ■

- French classes respect the official standards of the *Education Nationale* and often go beyond these standards in order for the students to master all subjects.
- English language teaching plays a key role in the curriculum. Pupils prepare for Cambridge



exams.

Young Learners Exams (Y.L.E) and Key English Test (K.E.T).

- Reading is taught using the **Syllabic Method**, guaranteeing excellent spelling and comprehension skills.
- Cultural and educational outings are organized: museums (Louvre, Centre Pompidou, ...), theater, visits to monuments, etc.
