Cours Molière welcomes Middle School students in small classes in a caring and highly international environment, where more than 35 nationalities are represented. It is not necessary to be bilingual to join the school.

The innovative teaching methods enable young people to flourish and reach their full potential. Students at Cours Molière International School are accepted into the best institutions in France and abroad (McGill University, London School of Economics, Sciences Po Paris, New York Fashion Institute of Technology, Concordia University Montreal...).

- From Year 7 to Year 9, pupils benefit from stimulating teaching in **small classes**. An innovative and dynamic approach helps each young person achieve their full potential.
- English language teaching accounts for 1/4 to 1/3 of the week. English is taught in groups according to level (Anglophone group – Francophone group) and students receive up to 10 hours of teaching time in English.
- Students at Cours Molière – International School come from all over the world, so English is not confined to the classroom; it is used spontaneously among students and in their interactions with adults.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

The tuition fees, half boarding fees, and annual study hall fees are payable in one of 2 methods:

- **Method 1:** One-time Payment: before September 1st

With a 5% reduction on the amount of tuition fees, or euros.

- **Method 2:** Registration Check of 3,000€ + 3 Payments (check: August 15th ; November 15th ; February 15th)

IMPORTANT: Registration is definitive only after the school receives the payment of 3,000€: **registrations are accepted only for one year long. Registrants must pay for the entire school year, even in case of cancellation.**

- Fun educational workshops: every Friday, 'Cultural Fridays' offer students the opportunity to work together in workshops, practice music or theatre, visit museums, and much more.
