Cours Molière welcomes students in small classes in a caring and highly international environment, where more than 35 nationalities are represented. It is not necessary to be bilingual to join the school.

The school's effective and innovative methods allow students to flourish in a supportive environment and achieve academic success, both in France and abroad.

- A stimulating learning environment from Year 1 onwards, in small classes (15 pupils per class).
- A caring approach to help each child reach their full potential.
- Teaching in French follows the French National Curriculum and goes well beyond it.
- Teaching in English, from Year 1 to Year 6, accounts for between a third and half of our pupils' week.
- Pupils at Cours Molière – International School come from all over the world: English is used very spontaneously among children and in their exchanges with adults, and as such is placed on an equal footing as French within the school.
- Supervision and security: Teachers and assistants supervise all recreational activities, meals in the cafeteria, and the daycare.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

The tuition fees, half boarding fees, and annual study hall fees are payable in one of 2 methods:

- **Method 1:** One-time Payment before September 1st

With a 5% reduction on the amount of tuition fees, or euros.

- **Method 2:** Registration Check of 3,000€ + 3 Payments (check: August 15th ; November 15th ; February 15th)

IMPORTANT: Registration is definitive only after the school receives the payment of 3,000€: **registrations** are accepted only for one year long. Registrants must pay for the entire school year, even in case of cancellation.

LE PETIT MOLIERE

▪ A SUPPORTIVE TEACHING STAFF ▪

- **A dynamic teaching team:** teachers are recruited for their **kind** and **caring** approach to education. Available throughout the year, they are happy to meet with parents on request.
- **An international DNA:** 30% of the staff members are English-speaking.

▪ PARENT-STAFF MEETINGS ▪

To keep the family informed, 2 meetings are organized during the year.

▪ THE PETIT MOLIERE METHOD ▪

Small class sizes provide a comfortable learning environment for each pupil. A dedicated teaching team implements unique curriculums to impart essential knowledge using methods that are both **stimulating** and **enjoyable**. Encouraged by **a nurturing environment**, each pupil learns to give their best.

The curriculum is designed to comply fully with the French National Education and often goes beyond it.

The Cours Molière educational project is based on its classes with a high level of supervision. In groups of around 15 pupils, children thrive in a warm and safe international environment.

- **Intensive English practice** with Anglo-Saxon teachers and teaching modules that follow English-language programs.
- **A holistic educational approach:** thanks to small class sizes, there are numerous activities on offer, including singing, art workshops, physical education, museum visits, etc. The aim is to help each child reach their full potential, whatever their talents.

Small class sizes contribute to greater efficiency:

→ in small groups, children are more attentive and receptive during the day: for this reason, **written exercises are done during school hours**; pupils practice directly with their teachers, who are fully trained to answer their questions and teach them the appropriate methods;

→ To make better use of families' time, only homework that does not require writing should be done after school (vocabulary learning, poetry revision, reading, etc.). This allows children to make the most of their time at home and their extracurricular activities.

- **Specialized care for non-francophone children** is offered: English classes are based on proficiency levels and French classes (Français Langue Etrangère, or F.L.E.) are held with a specialist.
- **The Molière Spirit:** Like in British schools, each student wears a coat-uniform provided by the school. This allows the child to integrate more easily with the class.
- **Introductory Chinese classes** every week in Kindergarten and Primary School.

▪ LA MATERNELLE – KINDERGARTEN ▪

- A **reassuring environment**: children discover the joy of learning in a **caring** and **stimulating** educational setting.
- Daily practice of English with native English-speaking teachers and English activity books.
- Our goal: to promote learning through fulfilment and encouragement.

▪ LE PRIMAIRE – PRIMARY SCHOOL ▪

- **French classes** respect the official standards of the *Education Nationale* and often go beyond these standards in order for the students to master all the subjects presented.
- English language teaching plays a key role in the curriculum. Pupils prepare for Cambridge

exams.  :

Young Learners Exams (Y.L.E) and Key English Test (K.E.T).

- Reading is taught using the **Syllabic Method**, guaranteeing excellent spelling and comprehension skills.
- Cultural and educational outings are organized: museums (Louvre, Centre Pompidou, ...), theater, visits to monuments, etc.
